



Checklist before the technical inspection

- DIRECTION** Check at the wheel, that there is no game, that the steering is done without difficulty.

- VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION** Check your license plates at the back and front: check their visibility and attachment.

- VISIBILITY**
 - Make sure your windshield is not damaged.
 - Check the glazing of your vehicle.
 - The fixing and condition of your mirrors (interior and exterior).
 - Check your windshield wipers.

- LIGHTING SIGNALLING** Check the operation and condition of all lights (front-rear):
Position and dipped-beam headlamps, turn signals, stop lamps, hazard warning signals, rear fog lamps, retro-reflectors and registration plate lighting.

- GROUND CONNECTION** Check the condition and pressure of your tires, if they are deformed, torn or worn (less than 1.6 mm tread depth) you need to change them.

- VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION** Check your license plates at the back and front: check their visibility and attachment.

- ORGANS MECHANICAL**
 - Check the oil level.
 - Make sure your exhaust doesn't make any abnormal noise.
 - Check that your exhaust pipe is securely secured.

- BRAKING**
 - Have the condition of the jaws and platelets checked.
 - Check your brake fluid level and see if the cap is missing.

- STRUCTURE AND BODYWORK**
 - No protruding parts that could injure a person.
 - Check the correct opening and closing of your doors, trunk and hood.

- EQUIPMENT**
 - Check the proper functioning of your seat belts:
no cut, tear and that they lock properly.
 - Make sure the driver's seat is adjusted (front-rear).
 - Check the working status of your horn.

- POLLUTION SOUND LEVEL** Check that the exhaust fumes are not abnormal in color (black, blue, white) and do not come out in too large quantities.
